## Class Descriptions



### **Seeing Art, hands-on Art History & Appreciation with Amber Jones**

**Mondays 10-11:30, 5-8 year olds, Class meets in the YMCA Music Room**

In Seeing Art for 5-8 year olds we will explore and connect with the life, times and artwork of 5 famous artists. Our first class will be our gallery day. On gallery day we will choose together which 5 artists we would like to study out of the 16 presented. We will also begin our art cards which will be the student's personal collection of 24 pieces of famous artwork for enjoyment and games.

In our remaining 8 class times we will explore our chosen artists through: analysis and discussion, stories, games, group activities and creativity in the form of an art project designed to connect with the art or artist presented.

Each Student will bring home from each class further cross curricular activities that can be easily achieved at home in the areas of: Art, Language Art, Writing, Math and Social Studies.

## **Fencing with Len Carnighan**

**Tuesdays or Thursdays 11:45-12:45, 9 & up, Class meets in the YMCA Gym**

Len Carnighan has taught fencing at universities and clubs for almost 40 years. He is a trained Fencing Master in foil, epee, and sabre, he holds a Master's certificate from the Selberg Fencing Academy, and he has held a Class 1 Director's rating from the United States Fencing Association (USFA). Len has also taught both primary and secondary school levels (grades 2-12) and has produced top-rated national and international fencers including 3 National Championships. Although proficient at producing competitive fencers Len's personal goal as a teacher is to produce outstanding examples of the sport who will be a welcomed addition to any fencing club in the world.

The classes in the Port Townsend area will be primarily held in foil, but individual lessons will be available in all 3 weapons. Beginning classes will provide both an appreciation of the art and sport of fencing, as well as a technical foundation in the use of the foil and its corresponding footwork. It is through the practice of footwork that a vigorous workout will be enjoyed.
